RESPECT WOMEN / GIRLS'S PRIVACY AND IMAGE

I care not to humiliate or make degrading comments about women's bodies, and I encourage acceptance and appreciation of bodies in all their diversity.

I practice the right to privacy by sharing personal information or content only with the consent of the person concerned. This applies even if the information I share is verified, and even if it's not the original content (screenshot, photomontage, deepfake (video or audio recording made or modified using artificial intelligence)).

I ATTEMPT TO CONTRIBUTE TO A POSITIVE AND INCLU-SIVE ONLINE CULTURE

In general, I encourage onine users to share content and behave responsibly and critically online.

I attempt to contribute to make digital spaces more welcoming by informing myself about and supporting initiatives and campaigns to raise awareness of gender inequality issues (I share, I comment, I like).
